

1. Produce Eligibility at the Margaret River Farmers' Market

The table below allows you to self-assess the chance of your application.

Origin of Produce/Products	Points
Grown by vendor, or manufactured primarily from ingredients which are grown/produced by vendor within the MRFM catchment	20
Manufactured primarily from ingredients sourced from within the MR region	15
Manufactured primarily from ingredients sourced from within the MRFM catchment	10
Manufactured primarily from ingredients sourced from within Australia (not available within the MRFM catchment)	5
Manufactured primarily from ingredients sourced from overseas (not available within Australia)	2
Processing	
Selling raw produce from the MRFM catchment directly, or high and/or complex level of processing of raw ingredients into a speciality product (e.g. Tempeh, Cheese, Wine, Chocolate)	15
Medium level of processing of raw or processed ingredients (e.g. Jerky, Chutney, tarts)	10
Blending of raw or processed ingredients to a unique speciality product (e.g. teas, spices)	5
Ingredients produced by vendor but processing outsourced, within the MRFM catchment	5
Ingredients produced by vendor but processing outsourced, outside the MRFM catchment	2
Simple combination of ingredients without processing	0
Location of food business	
Within the MR region	5
Within the MRFM catchment	0

A vendor is eligible to attend with a total of 20 points or more. However, despite achieving the points required to be eligible, an application may still be refused for other reasons (e.g. duplication, insufficient quality).

If you cannot achieve the points required using the eligibility point assessment, you can still apply to the MRRPA board if your product is unique and will contribute to the diversity of the market.
